# **Summary of Speaker Research Findings**

#### Abu Usamah At-thahabi

The Organization identified Mr. At-thahabi as a speaker at their December 14-16, 2012 event called *Go Halal or Go Home – Part II*. Research conducted by the CRA indicates that he attended additional events on January 2-5, 2014. and April 26-27, 2014.

In 2007, Abu Usamah At-thahabi, was videotaped for several months by undercover reporters for a British documentary called 'Undercover Mosque', produced by Channel 4. 'Undercover Mosque' contained footage of Mr. At-thahabi making the following statements at a mosque in Birmingham, England:

- Allah has created women deficient, even if she gets a PhD, deficient. Her intellect is incomplete, deficient.
- Take that Homosexual man and throw him off the mountain.
- They have given them unprecedented rights so that your child can be exposed
  and introduced to, to lesbians. Now they say if you discriminate against that
  you're going to jail. Allah he will discriminate, but we'll discriminate in a way
  where you don't get in trouble.
- No one loves the *kuffar*. No one loves the *kuffar*, not a single person here from the Muslims loves the *kuffar*, whether those *kuffars* are from the UK or from the US. We love the people of Islam and we hate the people of *kufr*. We hate the *Kuffar*.
- I don't believe them as they are *kuffar*, and lying is part of their religion. These *kuffars*, they do whatever they want to do.
- Christians and Jews are enemies to Muslims.
- I don't agree with those individuals (Muslim terrorists), but at the same time they are closer to me than those criminals of the *Kufr*.
- "Whoever changes his religion from Islam to anything else Kill him in the Islamic states.<sup>4</sup>

Mr. At-thahabi claimed that the documentary had taken his statements out of context and filed a complaint against Channel 4 with the UK media regulator, Ofcom, over the way the programme was edited.<sup>5</sup> Ofcom's investigation into the complaint found Mr. At-Thahabi's claims baseless and concluded that:

 Undercover Mosque was a legitimate investigation, uncovering matters of important public interest... On the evidence (including un-transmitted

footage and scripts). Ofcom found that the broadcaster had accurately represented the material it had gathered and dealt with the subject matter responsibly and in context.<sup>6</sup>

In a lecture on adultery and fornication available on YouTube, Mr. At-thahabi makes the following statements:

- It is not permissible for the Muslim man to marry the non-Muslim women, nor is it permissible for the Muslim woman to marry the non-Muslim man under any circumstances
- To marry the Sikh, to marry the Hindu, to marry anyone who is an atheist is not permissible in Islam.
- But even greater than that is the *zina* of homosexuality and the *zina* of lesbianism. The prophet said "Kill the one who does it and the one who it's being done to, Kill the one who was on top and the one who was on the bottom whether it's a man or a women," and this is going to come *inshallah*.<sup>7</sup>

### Abu Ameenah Bilal Philips

Mr. Philips participated in an event hosted by the Organization on June 22-23, 2012. The title of his lecture was *Distinguishing the fire of desire*. <sup>8</sup> This event was identified by the Organization.

According to media reports, Mr. Philips has been denied entry into Australia, the United Kingdom. Kenya, Bangladesh, the United States, and Germany. Furthermore, an article in the September 10, 2014, National Post reported he had been detained and deported from the Philippines for "inciting and recruiting people to conduct terrorist activities." <sup>10</sup>

An April 11, 2011, article detailing the debate surrounding Mr. Philips' visit to Denmark, quotes American terror expert Lorenzo Vidino<sup>11</sup> as describing Mr. Philips as follows:

"[h]e is extremely hardcore and has connections to radical people across the world. Although he might not directly encourage violence, there is no doubt that he harbours attitudes that are anti-Semitic, intolerant and contrary to integration." <sup>12</sup>

In addition, a video posting featuring Mr. Philips addressing the issue of suicide bombers argues that, while suicide in general is forbidden by Islam, suicide bombing in such contexts as Palestine and Chechnya is not. According to the statements made by Mr. Philips, in the normal context, a person takes their own life because they cannot stand to go on living – life has lost its meaning. A suicide bomber, however, has a different intention altogether – they are fighting in the situation where they are not able to get to the troops of the enemy. Therefore, the only option available is to get someone amongst them and then explode themselves in order to destroy equipment and save the lives of their comrades. Such an act is not really suicide in the true sense. Instead, it is a military action requiring the sacrifice of human lives. <sup>13</sup>

In the video, Mr. Philips also states that while Islam is opposed to terrorism in all forms – when it is true terrorism – Islam does not shrink from using violence to gain some of its ends, to establish itself in certain areas/to gain control of Muslim lands. Terrorism, he explains, is indiscriminate violence where people are not selectively killed because they represent the military opposition, but are rather killed to create fear and doubts. <sup>14</sup>

In his textbook, entitled *Contemporary Issues*, available on his Web site, Mr. Philips appears to defend pedophilia, saying that Mohammad's marriage to nine-year old Aisha, while violating current laws, was entirely acceptable according to Islam:

The prophet Muhammad practically outlined the rules regarding marriage prior to puberty. With his practice he clarified what is permissible and that is why we shouldn't have any issues about an older man marrying a younger woman, which is looked down upon by this society today, but we know that Prophet Muhammad practised it, it wasn't abuse or exploitation, it was marriage.<sup>15</sup>

In the same textbook, he makes the following statements about marital rape and domestic violence:

"[In] Islam, a woman is obliged to give herself to her husband and he may not be charged with rape." 16

"It is true that the *Sharee'ah* does permit a husband to hit his wife. Allah stated that in the Qur'aam (Soorah an-Nisaa, (4): 34). The Prophet also said, "You have rights over your women that they do not allow anyone you dislike into your home. If they disobey you, you may spank them. And the woman's right on you is that you clothe her and feed her justly, according to your means." However, that permission is under special conditions and with severe limitations. A husband is not permitted to beat his wife simply because she spilled his tea, burn this toast, forgot to iron, his shirt, etc. for example. The Qur'aan permission given is specifically in the case of divorce, as a last resort to save the marriage. The Qur'aanic verse outlines the procedures which should be followed in the case of a rebellious and unjustly disobedient wife. She should first be verbally advised of her obligations. If that fails, the husband should then cease having sexual relations with her. Failing that, if the husband sees it useful, and as a final step in order to bring her back into the line he is allowed to hit her."

Lastly, he refers to homosexuality as a 'deviant lifestyle', and claims that "AIDS is enough to prove that homosexuality is evil and dangerous to society." <sup>18</sup>

## · Abdullah Hakkeem Quick

Mr. Abdullah Hakkeem Quick spoke at the Organization on May 12, 2012. The title of his lecture was *Calling to Allah in Times of Crisis*. <sup>19</sup> This event was not disclosed by the Organization during our audit; rather, it was identified by the CRA as being advertised on the Organization's Facebook page.

Mr. Quick was condemned, in 2004, by the New Zealand Broadcasting Standards Authority for his broadcasts which included these claims: "AIDS is caused by the 'filthy practices' of homosexuals"; 'homosexual are dropping dead from AIDS' and 'they want to take us all down with them'; the Islamic Position on homosexuality is 'death'; homosexuals are 'sick' and 'not natural' [and] 'Muslims are going to have to take a stand [against homosexuals] and it's not enough to call names." The Broadcasting Standards Authority ruled that:

The comments made in the programme were extreme and the Authority considers that they are aptly described as "hate speech". They went far beyond mere criticism of those with a homosexual orientation. Of particular concern, the speaker advocated death for homosexuals and suggested that Muslims should take an active stand against them, which a viewer might have interpreted as an incitement to violence.<sup>21</sup>

In addition, in a video lecture entitled "The History of the Crusades," Mr. Quick advocated for the Al-Agsa Mosque in Jerusalem to be liberated from the "filth" of the Jews:

May Allah subahanahu wa ta'ala clean and purify Masjid al-Aqşa from the filth of the yahud. May Allah *subahanahu wa ta'ala* clean Afghanistan and Iraq and all of the lands from the filth of the *Kafirun*<sup>22</sup>

### Said Rageah

Said Rageah delivered his first lecture at the Organization on December 30, 2009.<sup>23</sup> He delivered additional lectures on August 29, 2012, at the *Veils of Sins* event, at the October 11-12, 2013, *Restored Hope*<sup>24</sup> event, at the January 3-5, 2014. 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual Go Halal or Go Home event.<sup>25</sup> and at the May 27, 2013, *Money. Drugs, and Zina Affects Youth*<sup>26</sup> event. The Organization failed to disclose all but one event featuring Mr. Rageah.<sup>27</sup> All other events were revealed as a result of our own supplementary research conducted on the Organization's guest speakers.

The CRA also has concerns with regard to Mr. Rageah's relationship with the Al-Magrib Institute, <sup>28</sup> and his role as founder and leader of the *Journey of Faith* conference, which has afforded individuals known for their extremist opinions, an opportunity to address thousands of gatherers in Toronto. <sup>29</sup>

The Journey of Faith Conference—billed as North America's largest Islamic conference and slated to attract upwards of 10,000 people to the city early next month—features such personalities as Abdur Raheem Green, who has advocated "fighting jihad" and who was reportedly invited by the Christmas Day airline bomber to address British students in 2007, and Sheikh Hussein Yee, who once said Jews are the "extremists of the world" and will 'go to Hell"

The National Post reported yesterday that the conference's main speaker, Peace TV founder Dr. Zakir Naik, will not be allowed to enter Canada because of concerns surrounding past statements such as "every Muslim should be a terrorist," Jews are "our staunchest enemy," and "If [Osama bin Laden] is fighting the enemies of Islam, I am for him."

On July 4, 2010, the Toronto Star reported that Zakir Naik was banned by the Canadian Government from speaking at the
conference, Mr. Naik was then scheduled to speak to the conference via live video. According to the article:

Finally, we note that on December 4<sup>th</sup>, 2014, the <u>Newcastle Herald</u>, reported that Mr. Rageah had been denied entry to Australia, where he had been scheduled to speak at an Islamic event in Perth.<sup>30</sup> According to the article:

Mr Rageah has in the past advocated the banning of alcohol, gambling and prostitution. He has also displayed anti-Western and homophobic attitudes. "Homosexuals, they are fighting [for] their rights day and night, and then it became legal and you cannot do anything about it," he said in a Youtube video. In that same video he described non-Muslims using the Arabic slur 'kuffar' ... meaning "infidel" or "unbeliever".
